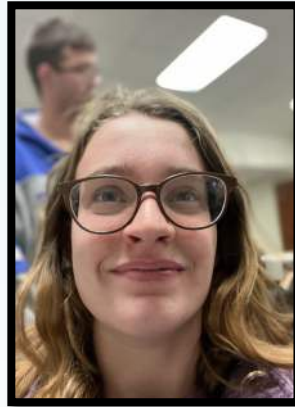

My Trip to Atlanta

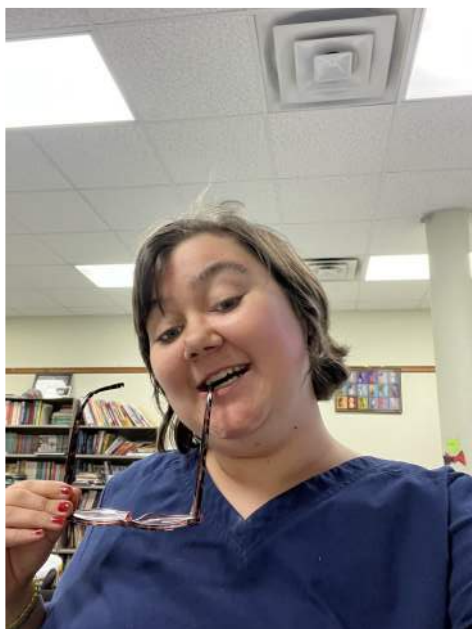

Theodor Geisel was an American children's author and cartoonist. He is known for his work that includes writing and illustrating more than 60 books under the pen name Dr. Seuss. He was born on March 2, 1904 in Springfield, Missouri and died on September 24, 1991 in La Jolla, California. Some of Dr. Seuss's most famous books are:

- *The Cat in the Hat*
- *How the Grinch Stole Christmas*
- *Green Eggs and Ham*
- *Lorax*
- *One Fish, Two Fish, Three Fish, Four Fish*
- *Oh! The Places You'll Go*
- *Horton Hears a Who*

Three of his books were made into movies. His most famous work is *How the Grinch Stole Christmas*.
